


Project Description:

- Come explore Western New York's Allegany State Park - home to 65,000 acres of primitive forested valleys, and un-glaciated landscape. The project is a multi-year effort to revitalize the 20.6 miles of Finger Lakes Trail /North Country National Scenic Trail within Allegany State Park. Volunteers will work together to reroof and stain a lean-to,, install switchbacks on a steep section of trail, replace 12 feet of at bridge, drainage cleaning, installation of water bars/rolling dips and removing slough and berms from trail benching, repair an outhouse and cleaning up the general area and brush clearing and blazing.

Offsite Activity Description:

- Volunteers can explore the wealth of sightseeing and recreational opportunities within Allegany SP, visit the Seneca Nation Museum or Casino, the National Comedy Center or Lucille Ball Desi Arnez Museum, etc.



Area and Attractions:

- Allegany State Park is located in Cattaraugus County just north of the Allegheny National Forest in Pennsylvania. The park is divided into two sections: The Red House Area and the Quaker Run Area. It lies within the Allegheny Highlands forest ecoregion. Allegany State Park was named as a top "Amazing Spot" in the nation in 2007. It has also been referred to as "the wilderness playground of Western New York."

Travel Details:

- Buffalo Niagara International Airport is the closest major airport. Airport pick up and drop off is available for volunteers and will be arranged upon confirmation of the trip. Pick-up is available at Buffalo Train Station.
